It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that pursuant to advertisement no.4/85, they had appeared in the examination conducted by the Bihar State Subordinate Service Selection Board which has subsequently been Service Public Bihar taken over by the Commission and they had secured requisite marks. many similarly It is further submitted that the but. situated persons were appointed petitioners were not appointed even though the posts remained vacant.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, I do not find any merit in this application. It is, accordingly, dismissed.
